RECYCLING GUIDELINES

HDPE

PLASTIC

#1 through #9 plastics



OTHER

All Items Must have Recycling Symbol Triangle!

Examples: Milk or juice jugs, detergent or bleach bottles, water or soda bottles, margarine, sour cream or cottage cheese containers.

How to Prepare: Rinse clean and remove lids and metal rings. Flatten if possible. Labels may be left on.

Not Accepted: Motor oil bottles, colored plastic bags without recycling triangle, styrofoam.

PAPER



Newspaper and all inserts, junk mail, printer or office paper.

Examples: Community newspapers, office paper.

How to Prepare: Stack neatly at curb in recycling bin or brown paper grocery bags. Please do not tie in bundles with string or rope.

Special: Magazines, phone books, paperback books; remove glue, staples, bindings & paper clips. Envelopes; remove plastic window.

Not Accepted: gift wrap, carbon paper, tissue, napkins, food packaging. No staples, glue or glued bindings, paper clips, waxed or coated paper.

Note: Please Keep dry! Wet paper or those placed or left in plastic bags will be rejected.

METAL

Tin and aluminum cans, aluminum pans, aluminum foil and trays, metal lids

Examples: Food and beverage cans, pie tins, food trays, all aluminum pots and pans.

How to Prepare: Empty and rinse clean, flatten if possible.

Not Accepted: Large metal objects, foil with food residue, paint cans, appliances, hangers, aerosol cans, pots and pans with plastic handles or nonstick surface.

CARDBOARD

Corrugated and non-corrugated boxes and boxboard, cardboard food or beverage packaging.

Examples: Cereal boxes, gift boxes, packing boxes.

How to Prepare: Empty, flatten if possible and please keep dry.

Not Accepted: No oil or food soaked cardboard including used pizza boxes. No cardboard with shiny or waxed surfaces.

GLASS

NO GLASS AT THIS TIME!

The demand and acceptance of recycled materials are ever changing. Items such as glass and styrofoam are not accepted at this time, but may again be accepted in the future. As we receive updates, we will make every effort to keep you informed.

Please Make Sure

All Items Are Clean and Dry!

Any items left in your recycling bin after service should be discarded with your regular trash, as they are not compatible with our recycling collection service.

Please store all recycling in your bin or paper bags only! NO PLASTIC BAGS!

- Place your recycling at the curb before 7:00 A.M. on your scheduled collection day.
