Dear Council:

Livingston County Habitat for Humanity (LCHFH) has served our community since 1992 helping families with safe and affordable housing. In 2025, we completed and sold two homes to partner families and helped over 100 other families with critical home repairs.

Working with the Chamber of Commerce, Police, DPW and Village administration, we hope to bring a supporting event to the July 17, 2026 Food Truck Friday event by hosting a 5k/10k fun walk/run. We believe runners, walkers and their families will join the other Food Truck Friday participants for the 6:00pm start and hang around after the walk/run supporting Food Truck Friday. We are planning on offering each run/walk participant a \$5 voucher for use at the food truck of their choice.

We will host this walk/run to raise awareness of Habitat's services to the community and will be accepting applications for critical home repairs. We also hope to raise funds helping us to fulfill our mission of helping others.

As a 501(c)(3), we are asking for the waiver of Village fees associated with hosting the event in conjunction with the July 17, 2026 Food Truck Friday. 89.9% of all funds LCHFH raises supports our mission in the County. Therefore, reducing one dollar of expense for this event translates into \$.90 able to be reinvested in our community.
